

PHOTOGRAPHY CLUB CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE

We the students of Hillsborough Community College, School of Visual and Performing Arts, hereby establish the Photography Club. The Photography Club shall provide the means for students interested in photography to express an artistic voice, participate in activities which will enhance their understanding and appreciation of the photographic medium, and allow an opportunity to exhibit, discuss and critique photographic artwork.

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of the organization shall be the Photography Club.

ARTICLE II – MEMBERSHIP

All students currently or previously registered in an art or photography course at Hillsborough Community College School of Visual and Performing Arts, Ybor Campus, as well as any interested HCC (Ybor) students who wish to be involved in the club, shall be eligible for membership if they meet the SGA eligibility requirements.

ARTICLE III – PURPOSE

The purpose of this organization shall be to:

- (a) Provide members with the opportunity to expand their knowledge and appreciation of this medium (Photography) and the artist who use this medium.
- (b) Provide a relaxed (non-classroom) atmosphere where students will be able to exhibit and critique each others work, look at photography exhibitions, and communicate their views to one another.

ARTICLE IV – ELECTIONS

- (a) Shall be held the first club meeting of the semester.
- (b) Shall be held only at the Ybor campus
 - 1.) Members may vote using a valid current term registration card
 - 2.) Members may vote using a valid current picture identification

ARTICLE V – ELIGIBILITY

- (a) Members must maintain at least half time enrollment (6 hours) at the college.
- (b) Members must have a 2.0 GPA.
- (c) Members must have a 2.5 GPA to be on the executive board (officer in the club).
- (d) Members must have a 2.5 GPA to travel utilizing student activities funds.

ARTICLE VI – AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION

This constitution may be amended by the club advisor/sponsor, if they see the necessity of doing so.
