

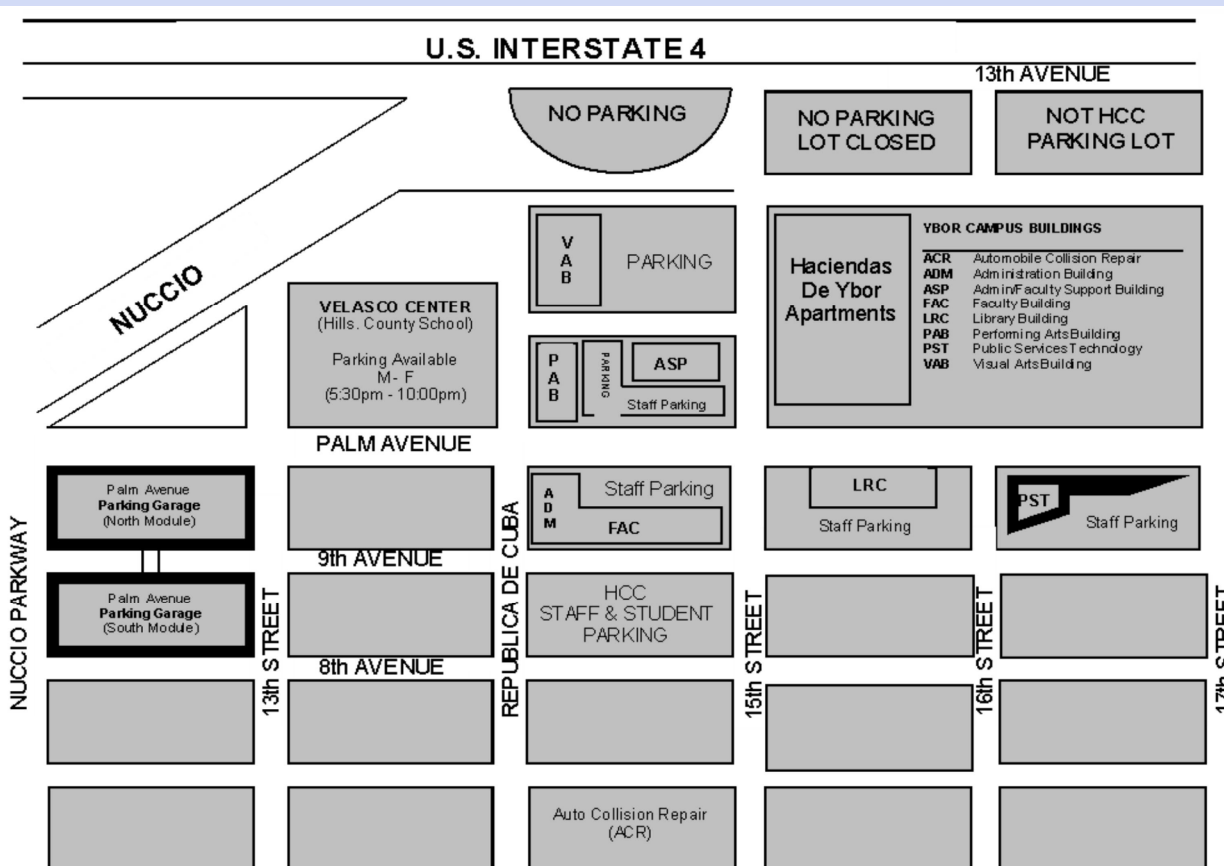

Instructor Techniques

This Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission Course is eighty (80) hours in length and is approved for mandatory retraining only.

This will be the first Instructor techniques course offered using the latest curriculum updates. This curriculum now reflects changes that the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and instructors throughout the career field have diligently worked to perfect. It also works hand-in-hand with the latest changes to the new basic recruit curriculum that more accurately instructs job tasks performed and utilizes new scenario based training. Students will be instructed in the use of adult learning models and facilitation skills to conduct application-based activities such as individual and group exercises, problem solving scenarios, practice demonstrations, and peer evaluations.

In this course, students will have an opportunity to define, explore, and develop each of the skills of an instructor. Students will learn about the types of liability associated with instruction, their responsibility to act ethically and without bias, and how to control and document classroom activities. Students will study how to design instruction, write objectives and test questions, and prepare lesson plans. In addition, students will examine the types of instructional methods and techniques that can increase learning.

- Facilitation Skills
- Group Management
