

**SouthShore Campus Advisory Council**  
**Meeting Highlights**  
**March 1, 2010**

- Dr. Witt continues to tackle the issues involving the growth of SouthShore and announced the addition of more portables being installed for the Fall semester. Dr. Witt also discussed the possibility of a new building ahead of the previous schedule.
- Due to the growth at Southshore, we have exceeded the required number of FTE students to be designated as a campus. Dr. Witt announced his plan to submit a request for official campus designation to Dr. Stephenson before her departure.
- Many thanks, to Rick Chorzelewski and John Bowen who recently completed training on how to help the campus run more efficiently.
- CITT is proposing a summer institute for online learning. The institute would be open to full-time faculty, with the possibility of offering the program to Adjunct faculty as well.
- Dean Nolasco plans to bring workforce programs to SouthShore to offer more educational opportunities to the community. New courses for the Fall semester will include medical coding and billing.
- SouthShore will be hiring four more faculty members for the Fall semester. When the new faculty members are on board, Southshore's full time faculty will be at 40%. Dr. Witt also noted that the District Vice-President is looking at Faculty needs for all of the campuses.
- Emergency call boxes are being installed on the campus. Each box has an emergency beacon and can be programmed for CCTV.
- SouthShore has a new evacuation assembly area. The East and West Parking lots will now be the assembly area. This change was made due to safety concerns stemming from the practice fire drill that was held last month.
