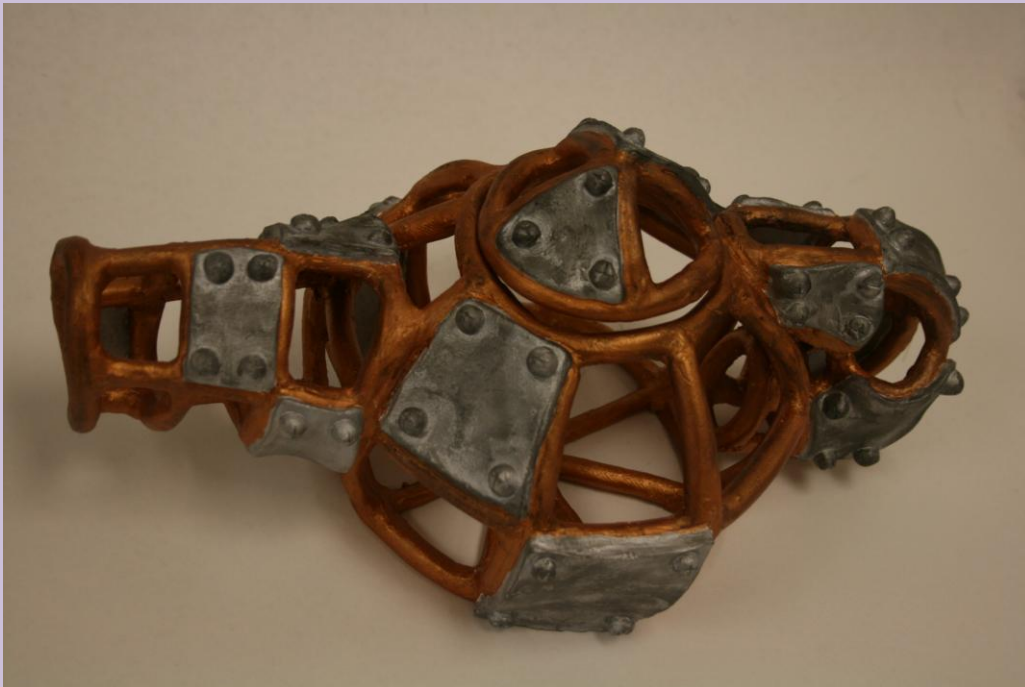

Holiday Cookie Contest Winner: Paula Babilacqua's Shortbread Cookies

Momma's Christmas Cookies

(Shortbread Cookies)

3/4 butter or margarine, softened

1/4 cup sugar

2 cups all purpose flour



Heat the oven to 350 degrees. Cream the butter and sugar together thoroughly. Add in the flour. If the dough is crumbly, mix in 1-2 tablespoons of soft butter.

Roll dough between 2 sheets of wax paper to about 1/4 inch thickness. It helps to lightly sprinkle the wax paper with a tiny bit of flour so the dough doesn't stick to it. Once rolled out pull the wax paper off the top then use your favorite cookie cutters to cut your cookies. Do not remove them from the lower sheet of wax paper! Place the entire sheet in the freezer for about 15 minutes; it will make the soft dough easier to handle. Remove from the freezer and lift the cookies off the remaining sheet of wax paper onto a cookie pan lined with aluminum foil (we like the "Easy Release"). Bake for about 12 to 15 minutes until the edges just barely begin to turn brown. Cool completely! Then decorate with butter cream icing. Leave out over night, uncovered, so the icing will dry. Enjoy!

Butter Cream Icing

1/2 cup stick butter (No butter spreads!)

1/2 cup Crisco

1 teaspoon vanilla

1 pound confectioner's sugar

Blend all ingredients together. Use milk to thin if necessary, one tablespoon at a time. Divide into 4-5 small bowls and then add food coloring to each bowl. Color icing with food color paste for brighter colors. Place icing in disposable decorator bags. We like to use the star tip to create easy decorations.
