**Openings at the HCC Child Development Centers!!**

The Ybor Child Development Center has 5 openings in the three-year-old classroom, and the Dale Mabry Child Development Center has 3 openings in the three-year-old classroom and 3 opening in the Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK) classroom. To be eligible for the Florida State voluntary pre-kindergarten program, children must turn four before September 1<sup>st</sup>. The program hours for VPK are free, but there is a charge for before and after child care services.

Both centers are open from 7:30 am – 5:30 pm, Monday through Friday. Both centers are teaching lab schools for students enrolled in the Early Childhood program, and other programs such as opticianary and dental hygiene utilize the centers for observations and practicum experiences.

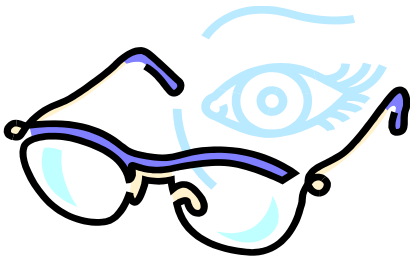
