\*The student can complete these requirements for the BSW degree in two calendar years. Course sequencing is an important feature of the BSW curriculum and, since a number of courses are offered only once a year, the student needs to begin this sequence in the September term in order to complete the program in two consecutive years.

Any student who seeks to earn the BSW degree at Saint Leo College will be given a social work faculty member to help work out the particulars of his/her academic program.
