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## Scholarship Application Procedure

It is **YOUR** responsibility to **REVIEW** the scholarship criteria to determine which specific scholarship you are eligible to apply for and to **FOLLOW-UP** on the progress of your application. However, HCC counselors are available to provide application forms and to assist you with the application process.

By following the guidelines listed below, you can simplify the application process and improve your chances of obtaining a scholarship.

1. **Read** the criteria carefully to determine whether or not you are eligible to receive the scholarship.
2. **Meet** with an HCC counselor to obtain **application forms** and to discuss the application procedure.
3. You may be eligible for more than one scholarship. **Assemble** a packet for **each** scholarship for which you wish to apply and be certain to include **all required** information. If official transcripts **are** required, you must supply certified transcripts from each college or university you have attended. Sample resumes and a cover letter are included in this book for your reference. Ask your references for "To Whom It May Concern" letters, so that the letters can be used for various scholarships. **Keep a copy of each packet for your own records.**
4. **HCC Transcripts.** If you are applying for a scholarship through an HCC Counseling Office, the counselor will request a copy of your HCC transcript (at no cost to you) and forward it along with your application packet to the appropriate committee. If you are applying directly to an organization, it is your responsibility to request and pay for an official copy of your transcript(s).
5. **Neatness Counts!** Applications, cover letters and resumes should be typed.
6. **Observe Deadlines!** Plan to submit your application **before** the deadline, especially if the counselor will need to request copies of your HCC transcript.

 -Earned a diploma from a Florida high school  
 -Be prepared to attend HCC as a part-time student with a minimum course load of 6 credit hours per term  
 -Maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA per semester  
 -Demonstrate financial need  
 -Be prepared to release all academic information to selected Migrant Education personnel  
 -Cannot be receiving other HCC funded scholarships
