

Transfer Centers

Transfer centers are available in the student services office at each campus. Transfer Center advisors are there to help students research, investigate, and ultimately choose a four-year institution to pursue their baccalaureate.

Vocational Rehabilitation Services

The Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, the Division of Blind Services, the Veterans Administration, and government agencies fund academic and vocational (technical) training for individuals with disabilities. For information about services and eligibility requirements and for referral to the appropriate agencies, students should contact an HCC coordinator of services for students with disabilities.

WINGS

The WINGS program is designed to promote the graduation of students pursuing two-year AS, AAS, or College Certificate programs. A variety of support services are offered to address short-term as well as lifelong goals. Students may qualify for partial tuition and textbook support, in addition to childcare assistance. Bus passes may also be available.

To qualify, students must be enrolled in a Technical Education program and be eligible to receive a Federal Pell Grant.
