

will be applied to General Education Requirements of the catalog year chosen for graduation.

3. earn at least 25% of the credit hours applicable to the degree in residence at HCC.

In addition:

1. No more than four credit hours of physical education activity/skills courses may be applied toward a degree.
2. Students may apply only 12 hours of ENS/EAP college level credits toward a degree.
3. Students must have a 2.0 cumulative GPA, and their GPA in HCC courses must be 2.0.

NOTE: Credits from other colleges will be used in computing the GPA when they are part of the credit hours used for graduation.

4. Students must complete the capstone course for the AA degree. Prior to taking the course, students must have completed at least 45 hours of coursework towards the degree, including at least 24 hours of general education coursework with a minimum grade of C.
5. Students must earn appropriate CLAST scores for the AA degree (see CLAST) or satisfy one of the approved CLAST exemption alternatives.
6. Candidates must complete an application for graduation before the deadline (see the College operational calendar). A \$10 application fee is required for each degree.
7. Candidates must fulfill all financial obligations to HCC.
