And by earning an Associate in Arts (AA) degree at HCC, you can transfer as a junior to a state university and many private colleges.

University Transfer Program

The AA degree prepares you to meet the requirements to transfer as a junior to a college or university to continue to work toward a Bachelor's degree.

To earn an AA degree, you must complete a minimum of 60 credit hours with no less than 36 credits of specified general education courses and 24 credits in the university transfer program electives. See the HCC catalog for details concerning additional requirements.

You should contact the specific department of the institution where you plan to transfer as early as possible to make sure you are taking the right courses at HCC to make your transfer seamless.
