## **HCC NEW CRIMINAL JUSTICE TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM - Crime Scene**

**Tampa** - Hillsborough Community College (HCC) is now offering a College Credit Certificate Program in Crime Scene Technology designed to prepare graduates for work as crime scene technicians and technologists. Students can seek a Crime Scene College Credit Certificate alone or in conjunction with an Associates Degree in Criminal Justice with a Crime Scene Tract.

Crime Scene Technicians and Technologists specialize in the locating, identifying, processing, and preserving of evidence at crime scenes, identifying fingerprints, crime scene photography, as well as testifying in court as to their findings. City, county, state and federal law enforcement agencies, prosecuting attorneys' offices, and medical examiners' offices, as well as criminal and civil law firms and private industry, employ crime scene specialists.

Courses offered will include Introduction to Criminalistics, Introduction to Crime Scene Technology, Fingerprint Development and Classification, Forensic Photography, Courtroom Presentation of Evidence, Criminal Evidence and Criminal Investigations.
