Appraisers completing this course within the guidelines of Rule 61J1-4.001 may apply 20 hours of specialty credit (in the renewal cycle in which the course is completed) toward the continuing education requirements of Rule 61J1-4.003 (F.A.C.). After a licensee's successful completion of this course for continuing education credit, an attendance file must be electronically submitted to the department no later than 30 calendar days thereafter or prior to the licensee's renewal date, whichever occurs sooner. This course must be offered for the complete number of hours it is approved for, you can not offer it for partial hour credit. **Also, as required by Rule 61J1-4.001(10) each student shall receive a copy of the most current course approval letter, issued by the department, at the commencement of each course.**


