ARTICULATION AGREEMENT/ MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Between

St. Petersburg College, St. Petersburg, Florida And Hillsborough Community College, Tampa, Florida

Purpose

The intent of this Agreement is to facilitate the transfer and transition of related graduates ("the students") from HILLSBOROUGH COMMUNITY COLLEGE herein referred to as "HCC" into the Bachelor of Applied Science programs at ST. PETERSBURG COLLEGE herein referred to as "SPC". This Agreement will allow students to earn college credit at HCC that will transfer to the SPC's College of Technology & Management Bachelor in Applied Science in Technology Management (TMGT-BAS), Bachelor of Applied Science in International Business (INTBUS-BAS), Bachelor of Applied Science in Banking (BANK-BAS), Bachelor of Applied Science in Management and Organizational Leadership (MGTORG-BAS) or other appropriate BAS/BS programs.

HILLSBOROUGH COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO ST. PETERSBURG COLLEGE

1. This Agreement is to facilitate the acquisition of the baccalaureate degree for graduates of Hillsborough Community College's Associate in Science Degree Program(s) listed below:

- 2. This Agreement is based upon students' successful graduation from a Hillsborough Community College Degree Program listed in item 1 above.
 - a. Before being accepted into the SPC Bachelor of Applied Science, the students must have received an Associate in Science degree from HCC, to include general education and Gordon Rule requirements as applicable.
 - b. HCC students seeking admission to the SPC's College of Technology & Management program without an acceptable AS degree will be treated in accordance with regular SPC policy for transfer students.
 - c. Any student transferring into SPC from the HCC program and following the specifications of this Agreement will be accepted into the SPC Bachelor of Applied Science programs as a junior. It is also agreed that students graduating from SPC will be required to meet all requirements for the baccalaureate degree, to include thirty-six (36) hours at HCC of college level general education coursework, CLAST or approved alternative, two semesters of the same foreign language in college or two years from high school, and minimum hours to degree, as is more fully set forth for each SPC Bachelor of Applied Science program in Attachments A through D, attached hereto and made a part hereof.
 - d. It is understood that students must fulfill the SPC prerequisites for junior and senior level courses. Based on the HCC program from which the student is transferring, a minimum of specified credit hours must be completed at SPC to receive a Bachelor of Applied Science degree. SPC agrees to provide an academic advising report to each HCC student accepted into a Bachelor in Applied Science program detailing specific coursework required to complete the degree.
 - e. A minimum overall grade point average of 2.0 in all college level course work is required for acceptance by SPC. Transfer courses may include those courses completed through recognized proficiency testing programs (e.g., CLEP, ACT-PEP) or completed by alternative acceleration mechanisms acceptable to SPC and HCC.

Terms of Agreement

3. This Agreement is based on current curricula offered by St. Petersburg College and Hillsborough Community College. In the event that either party institutes curriculum changes which may affect this Agreement, the party instituting such curriculum changes shall provide notice to the other party of such changes. The parties shall use their best efforts to modify this Agreement in writing to address the issues arising from the curriculum changes. In the event the parties are unable to adequately address the curriculum change to the satisfaction of both parties this Agreement shall be terminated as of such date.

- 4. This Agreement will be effective beginning January 1, 2009 and shall continue unless otherwise cancelled or terminated as provided in this Agreement. Either party may terminate this Agreement at anytime (with or without cause) upon giving the other party no less than thirty (30) days notice from the date of termination set forth in the written notice of its intent to terminate.
- 5. If this Agreement is canceled or terminated as provided herein, such cancellation or termination shall not affect students enrolled in and accepted into the SPC program at the time of cancellation or termination, nor will it affect the status of students who have already matriculated into the Bachelor of Applied Science in Technology Management Program, at St. Petersburg College.
- 6. HCC and SPC agree that neither will discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin or marital status, or against any qualified person with a disability in its treatment of employees or students, and agree and recognize that sexual harassment constitutes discrimination on the basis of sex.
