

### PURPOSE

This rule establishes policy regarding programs of instruction and awards at Hillsborough Community College (HCC).

### RULE

Hillsborough Community College may provide instruction and confer appropriate degrees and college credit certificates or educational credentials for the following programs and areas of instruction.

1. Associate in Arts
2. Associate in Science
3. College Credit Certificate
4. Advanced Technical Certificate
5. Applied Technology Diploma
6. Postsecondary Adult Vocational Certificate
8. College Preparatory
9. Continuing Education
10. Contract Training for Business and Industry

Meta-major academic pathways shall be established for the purposes of advising Hillsborough Community College associate degree seeking students of the gateway courses that are aligned with their intended academic and career goals, in compliance with State Board of Education Regulations.

General education curriculum in the Associate in Arts program shall include the core options identified in State Board of Education Regulations. Remaining general education coursework shall be periodically reviewed by the General Education Committee and recommendations for changes shall follow the established process through academic affairs.

Credit awarded for online coursework and both certificates and credit awarded for non-credit programs shall follow the guidelines established State Board of Education Regulations.
