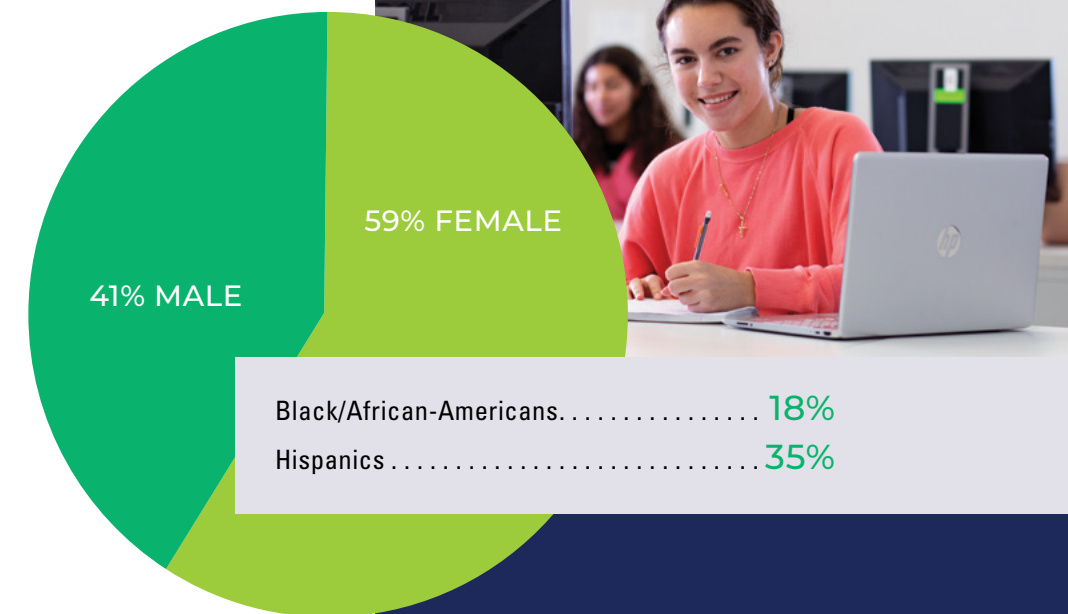
HCC impacts the social and economic viability of Hillsborough County by more than **\$1.3 billion** annually.
